



WFC POLICY STATEMENT

Communication Protocols On Education And Research

*Approved by the Assembly of the World Federation of Chiropractic
Washington DC, July 1995*

Education

Should an educational institution from one country wish to establish a chiropractic educational initiative in another country, approval and/or co-operation shall be sought and achieved from any existing national association of chiropractors within that other country or individual chiropractors recognised by the WFC as representative of chiropractic in that other country.

Where the country in which a chiropractic educational initiative is contemplated is without a national association or chiropractors recognised by the WFC as representatives of the profession in that country the institution involved should seek guidance on standards and approval from the WFC before initiating a program.

Research

Should an educational institution from one country wish to establish a chiropractic research initiative in another country, notification shall be given to any existing national association of chiropractors within that other country or any individual chiropractors recognised by the WFC as representative of chiropractic in that other country.
