
You inquired about Springfield Chiropractic College Springfield Chiropractic College was incorporated in Missouri in 1916 and located in Springfield by Luther S. Hunter.

The name was changed to Hunter School of Chiropractic in 1922.

Hunter had several addresses in Springfield, in 1922 They moved to a building on St Louis Street. Neither Hunter or the college appear in the 1928 city directory.

They may have moved or gone out of business. We hope this information is of value to you. Michael Glenn
