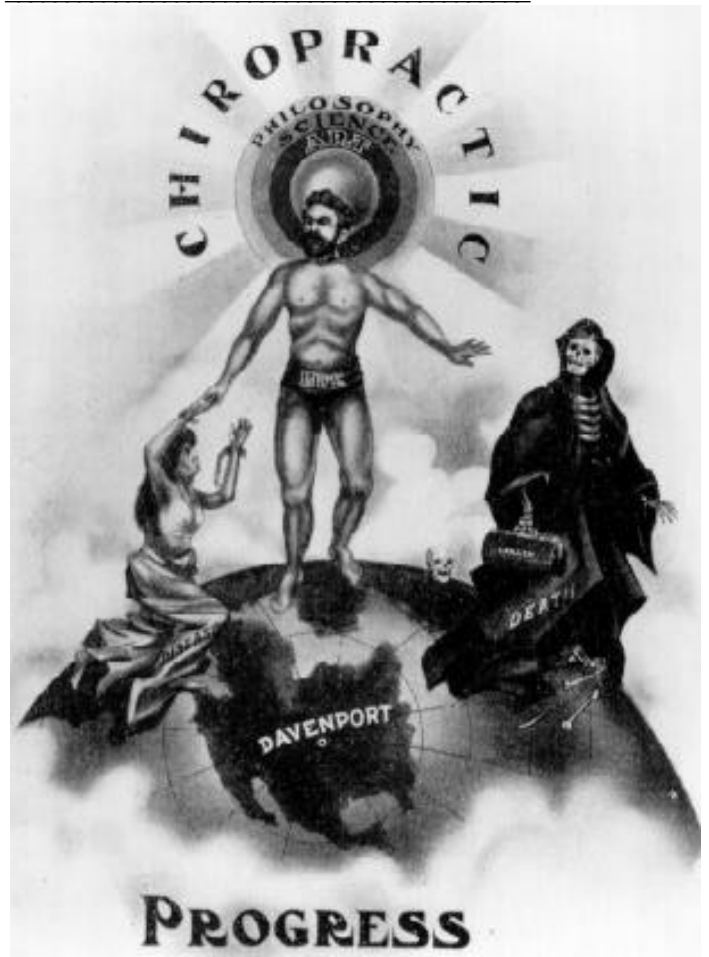

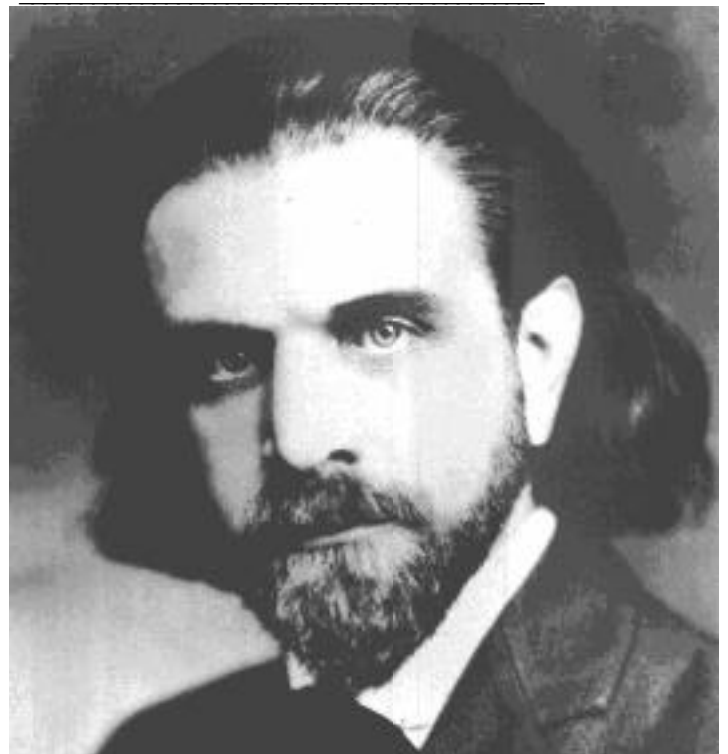

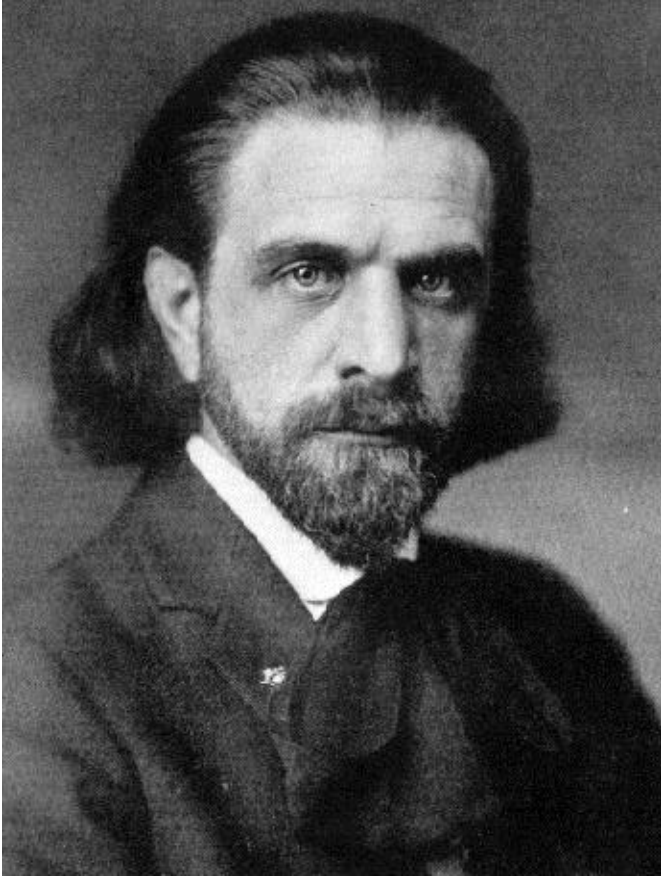


"BJ" sketch from the *Fountain Head News* 1920 [A.C. 25] (Feb 28); 9(22-23-24): 6



Fountain Head News 1924 [AC 29] (Apr 5); 13(15-16): 16



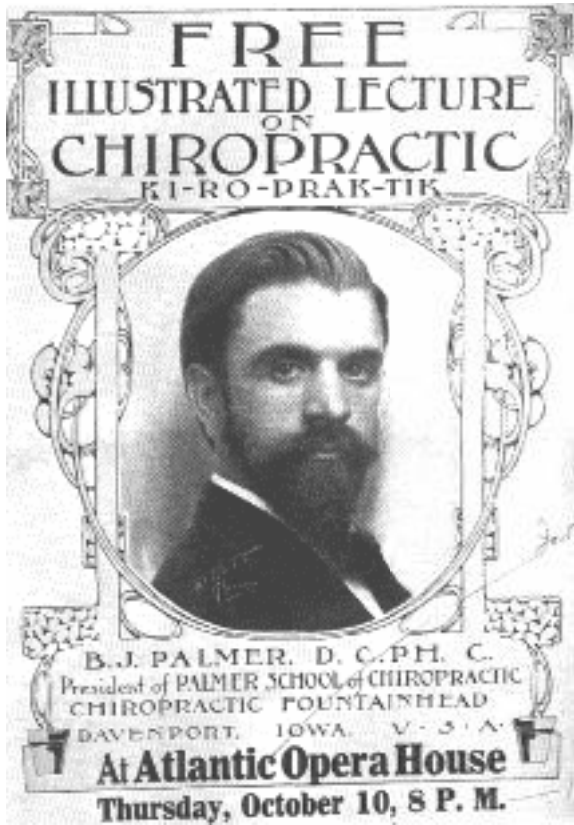

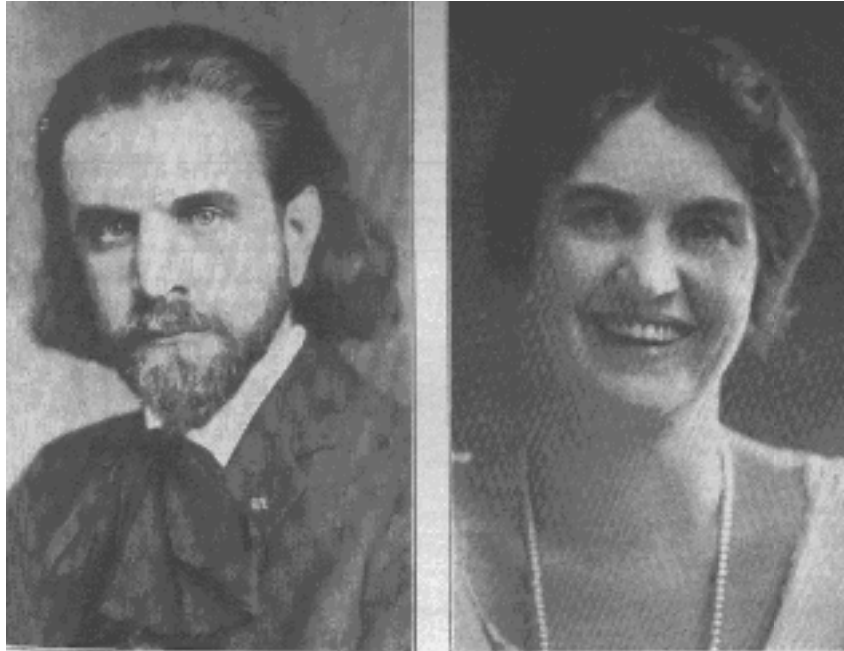
