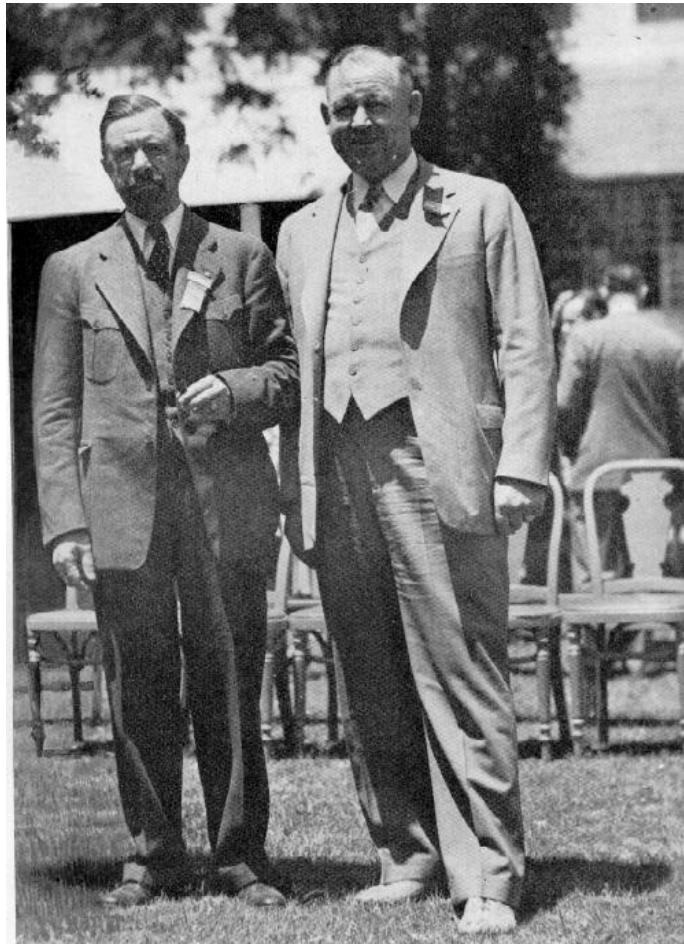




Figure ??-??: Part of Palmer's collection



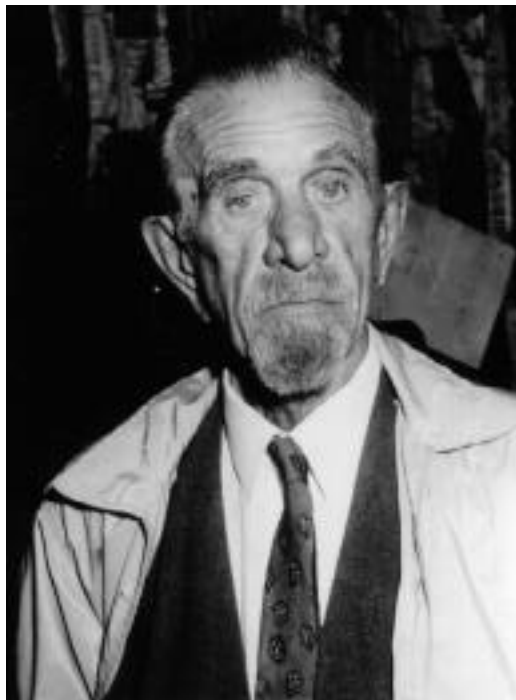
