1938 (Mar 27): death certificate for Charles A. Cale filed with the LA County Clerk (#2433; "Local Registered No. 38") indicates:

- -place of death was District 1965 of LA County, 3427 Michigan Avenue, Belvedere Twp [township], where he also resided; died at 7PM; no autopsy
- -Cale is widower, former wife's name is Astrid Cale
- -Cale had been in practice as a DC for 30 years
- -burial was at Inglewood Cemetery on 3/30/38
- -info provider for death certificate was Miss Nan Smethurst, 135 So. Townsend Ave, LA
- -funeral arrangements provided by J.C. Summers of the Bramble Funeral Home, 1816 So. Toberman, LA
- -E.E. Shook DC of 3860 Eagle St., LA signs death certificate, indicates he had attended Cale from 1/20/38 until his death; cause of death is given as "Acute ascending paralysis" with "cerebral hemorrhage"
