## Guide to the National Chiropractic Association's Photographic Collection

#### Overview of the NCA's Journal

The official journal for members of the National Chiropractic Association (1930-1963) commenced publication in 1931 as the Journal of the National Chiropractic Association, under the editorship of Benjamin A. Sauer, D.C., secretary of the organization (Keating & Rehm, 1993). At about the same time, the International Chiropractic Congress (1926-1934) persuaded Loran M. Rogers, D.C. of Webster City, Iowa to edit and publish the Journal of the International Chiropractic Congress (JICC). Dr. Rogers replaced Dr. Sauer as secretary of the National Chiropractic Association (NCA) in 1932 or 1933, at which time the JICC was renamed *The Chiropractic Journal*, and was jointly sponsored by the NCA and the International Chiropractic Congress (ICC). This joint sponsorship lasted until 1934, when the ICC dissolved. The Chiropractic Journal continued in publication as the official periodical of the NCA. In 1939 The Chiropractic Journal was renamed the National Chiropractic Journal, and in 1949 it was again renamed, becoming once more the Journal of the National Chiropractic Association (JNCA). When today's American Chiropractic Association was formed in 1963 and absorbed the NCA, the JNCA became the ACA's Journal of Chiropractic (renamed the Journal of the American Chiropractic Association in 1995). The numbering of volume-years of NCA's primary periodical during Dr. Roger's editorship can be confusing, since there is no Volume 2 nor Volume 13. For details of this numbering and renaming, see Table 1.

An *Author Index* to the text contents of the NCA's *Journal* is available (Hicks & Keating, 1988). The *Index* is not completely satisfactory, inasmuch as the contents listed on the title

pages were used in the index's compilation. Unfortunately, the titles of articles listed on these title pages do not always correspond to the titles listed at the beginning of the articles. Additionally, there are a number of articles and news items which appear in the *Journal* but not on the title pages. Accordingly, the *Index* is incomplete.

#### **Technical Aspects of Scanning & Storage**

With the development of inexpensive digital scanning technology, it was felt by the Board of Directors of the AHC that the surviving photographs of the NCA collection should be digitized, so as to make reproduction easy, inexpensive and readily available to all interested parties. Accordingly, the entire surviving collection was scanned, using a Hewlett-Packard "ScanJet 4p" flat-bed scanner connected to a Power Macintosh computer. The scanner has an optical resolution of 300 dots-per-inch (dpi), and with electronic enhancement via PaperPort software, a functional resolution of 1,200 dpi. Scanned images were embedded in word-processor files created using Microsoft Word, Version 6.0 for the Macintosh. In some cases reduction of the image by not more than 50% from the original was required in order to accommodate the limitations of the software. Some files contain single images, while others may hold as many as a dozen scanned images.

#### **Surviving Photographs**

The photographs and a few negatives collected by Dr. Rogers for publication in the NCA's professional *Journal* as well as for publication in the NCA's several patient magazines (*The Life Line, Healthways*) were passed along to the American Chiropractic Association (ACA) sometime after 1963. The ACA turned these photographs over to the Association for the History of Chiropractic (AHC) in 1982. Undoubtedly, many of the items collected by Dr. Rogers during his 31 years of editing and publishing for the NCA have been removed from the collection. However, several hundred photographs remain, spanning the period of 1930 through 1950. These are housed in the Archives section of the Daniel D. Palmer Health Sciences Library, a division of Palmer College of Chiropractic. The AHC is grateful to Palmer College and its librarians for assuming this responsibility. Photographic prints made from the surviving photos and negatives in this collection can be obtained from the Library for a small fee. (Contact: Glenda Wiese, M.A., Archivist, Daniel D. In preparing this photographic collection for digital storage, the subjects (persons, organizations, facilities, events) depicted in the photographs were identified wherever possible. The pages of the NCA's *Journal* were reviewed in order to try to identify the first appearance of each photograph in the *Journal*, thereby providing a chronological marker. Those scanned images for which a chronological marker could be added were placed in Macintosh folders labeled by year of publication. Additional folders were created especially for images related to the American Society of Military Chiropractors and the Chiropractic Research Foundation (forerunner of today's Foundation for Chiropractic Education & Research; see Keating et al., 1995). Macintosh "alias files" were created for those images which could appropriately be grouped in more than one folder. The few negatives in the collection are also placed in their own folder, "NCA Photo Negatives," with alias files in other appropriate folders.

In some cases neither the individuals nor objects depicted could be identified. These images were placed in a folder labeled "Various/unidentified." For other images, although one or more of the individuals depicted were identified, the date of the photo and/or date of publication (if any) is unknown to this writer. These images are stored in a folder labeled "People/Undated." I will be grateful to the reader for any assistance in further labeling/identifying subjects not yet recognized. Several dozens of images not found in the NCA photographic collection but available to the writer have been added to the digitally stored collection. These may be found in a folder labeled "Scans from JNCA & Elsewhere." These images were drawn from the pages (usually the covers) of the NCA's *Journal* or from the writer's files. Macintosh alias files for these images can also be found in other folders.

#### Copyrights

Copyright laws have changed since the images contained herein were created. Many of the individuals depicted in this photographic collection are now deceased. For the overwhelming majority of the images provided here, there are no surviving copyrights, and the pictures may be reproduced ad libidum. Moreover, the American Chiropractic Association has indicated to this writer that it makes no claim of continuing copyright for anything (text and images) published under the auspices of the National Chiropractic Association. In most instances, therefore, the images may be reproduced without concern of breach of copyright.

The AHC appreciates, but does not (cannot) require acknowledgment of the source of these images.
