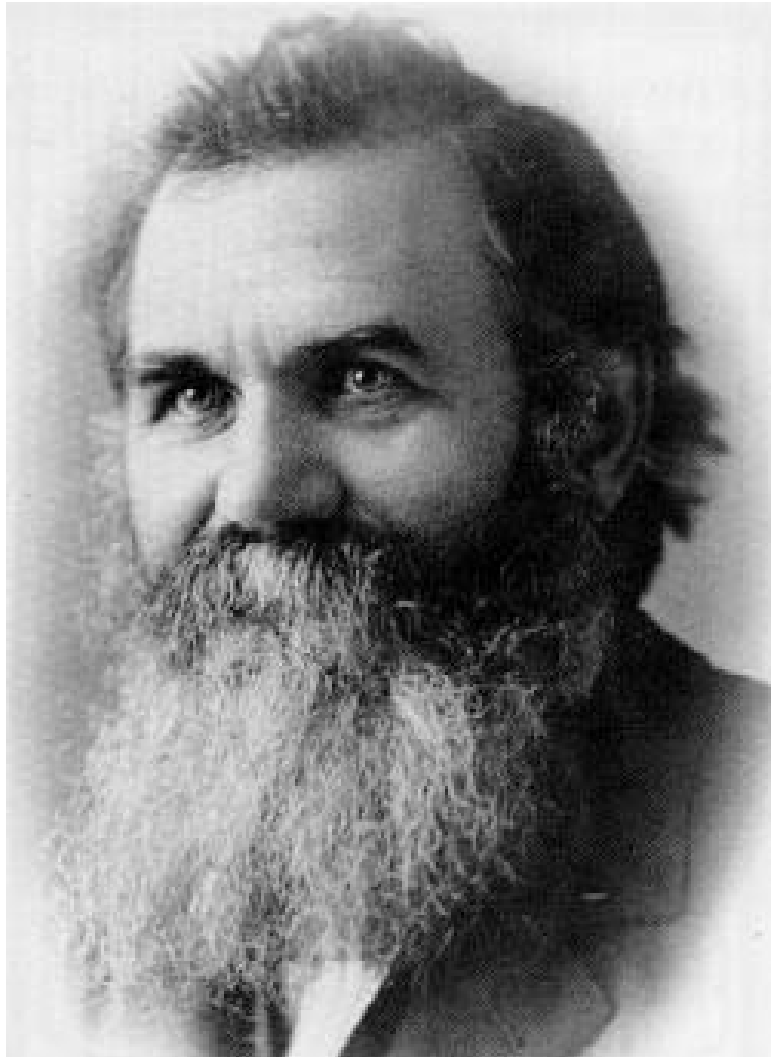


D.D. Palmer's Thoughts on Toxicology
